Edith Jane Wiley, 88, died peacefully on September 17, 2021. She was born in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania on May 7, 1933, the daughter of John and Florence Wilson. Jane grew up in Philadelphia with her younger siblings John David Junior (Jackie) and Florence, who Jane lovingly helped care for as they grew. The family moved to New Jersey in Jane's teenage years, where Jane would later start her own family and stay for many years. Jane married James Sherwin Wiley Junior on January 17, 1956 and together they raised three children: Brenda Joy, David, and James (Jimmy) Thompson. The family spent years moving across the United States with the U.S. Army, spending time in Virginia, Michigan, and Texas, but always returned to Gloucester County, New Jersey, where Jane called home. In 2014, Jane moved to Albuquerque, New Mexico to be close to her two sons.

Throughout her life, Jane's faith, love of music, and family were constant. She became a church organist at the age of 18 and would continue for over 60 years. Jane served as organist and Music Director at Elmer Presbyterian Church for many years, where she and husband, James, were cornerstones of the community. Jane was many things to many people: a devoted wife, loving mother, caring grandmother, loyal friend, skillful music teacher, and selfless member of the community.

She was preceded in death by her father and mother, brother, husband, and daughter. She is survived by her sister and brother-in-law, Florence and George Schaub; son David and partner Mark Watson of Albuquerque, NM; son Jimmy and partner Ronnie Apodaca of Albuquerque; granddaughters, Nicole Donnelly of Highlands, NJ, Melissa Donnelly of Philadelphia, PA, and Melinda Donnelly of Washington, DC; and two great grandsons, Jackson Tierney and Everett Donnelly-Schmeer.
