Louise met the love of her life, George Bowman, soon before he was sent off to war. They didn't get to know each other very well before he was shipped out, but she was encouraged by a neighbor to write to him. So, she did...and there began their story. The story that would result in creating a family of 6 ornery boys and one girl.

Despite having such a large family, Louise was always active. For years she was a Dutch Maid representative, having home parties...taking orders and delivering them. She was devoted to the Queen of Apostles Church. She was there at the church's groundbreaking, assisted with daily upkeep of the parish & hall, was a choir member and a member of the Alter & Rosary Society. She worked bingo every week and worked a booth at the church fair every year where you could take a chance at winning one of her homemade Raggedy Ann dolls. She also was an expert seamstress and crafter.

She and George were lovers of the outdoors. They regularly packed their children into their boat, found a beach along the C & D Canal and spent the afternoon swimming and fishing. Camping also became a family favorite and once they discovered Cherrystone Campground, in Virginia they fell in love.
