Adam Frank Szanyi, age 37, of Carneys Point, NJ passed away suddenly after complications from pneumonia on Saturday, December 9, 2023. Born in Dover, New Hampshire, he was the son of Frank and Margaret (Prettyman) Szanyi and he spent time growing up in New Hampshire and Ohio before his family moved to New Jersey in 1996. 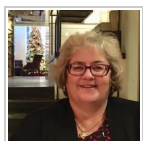
