Alejandro "Bobby" F. Mendez passed away unexpectedly on January 8, 2022. He was born In Vega Alta, PR, moved to the US, and raised in Penns Grove-Carneys Point, NJ.

Bobby graduated from Penns Grove High School in 1986 where he participated on the wrestling team. He was involved in bowling leagues, and later in pool leagues. Shortly after graduating, he began working at PGHS as a Security Officer, which lead Bobby with the passion of serving his community as a Correctional Officer at Salem County Jail for many years. He later transitioned as a Bounty Hunter. As Bobby began encountering restrictions secondary to his health, he began a private lawn service until disabled.

Bobby was an active member of Penton Chapel Church in Alloway NJ. He made many contributions to the management of the church, served as a member of the Penton Chapel Board of Trustees, co-chairman of the buildings and grounds committee, and handled all of the landscaping as long as he was able.

He loved immensely! He loved his children, family, friends, and those he did not know. He loved being on the phone for short time as he had many to call. He loved his church involvement, reading or having the Bible read to him.

He loved his music: Christian, Spanish, or Country.

He loved nature: being in the sun, or watching the rain or snow.

He loved his travels: Shady Maples, day trips boating/fishing/or crabbing to say the least, but mostly, he loved his recent trip to Dollywood.

He loved sports of all types, however, favored NFL football team, the Eagles; he would often say “get the tissues ready for when the birds make you cry”.

The list of his love goes on.

He was known for his relentless jokes... oh how they will be missed.

Bobby was the kindest, selfless, loving wholeheartedly man to all those encountered.

Those who knew him, lost a shining light in their lives. You will not see him, hear him, feel him... so look up to the sky, embrace all things he enjoyed. Feel the sun rays beaming upon you, the snow so ever gently touching your face, the rain disguising your tears, the gentle breeze or the swish of water movements whispering sweetness into your ears. 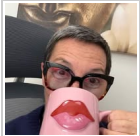

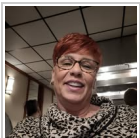

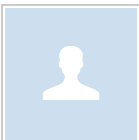
