In Memoriam: Dr. Amante DeCastro, MD

It is with profound sadness that we announce the passing of Dr. Amante N. DeCastro of Carneys Point, NJ, a beloved member of the community and a dedicated physician who touched the lives of many. Dr. DeCastro was born in Manila on August 1, 1942. He left an indelible mark on all those he met.

Dr. DeCastro was a pillar of the medical community, devoting his life to the field of obstetrics and gynecology. He excelled in his studies and graduated from medical school at the age of 21. He went on to do his fellowship in Endocrinology and Infertility in New York. For many years, he proudly served as a longtime Chief of Obstetrics at Salem Memorial Hospital, where he delivered over 20,000 babies throughout his illustrious career.

Beyond his medical practice, Dr. DeCastro was a dedicated community leader. He contributed his time and expertise to various organizations. Dr. DeCastro also served as a valued board member at Salem Community College, Salem Memorial Hospital, and Salem County Vocational Technical School. His passion for education and commitment to the betterment of his community were evident in his tireless efforts.

A proud Rotarian, Dr. DeCastro was an active member of the local Rotary Club. He embodied the organization's motto of "Service Above Self." His contributions to community service initiatives left an enduring legacy, and his kindness and compassion will be remembered by all.

Dr. DeCastro is survived by his loving wife, Lynn DeCastro, and their children,

Melissa (Nicholas Sommer) and Amante. He was also a cherished grandfather to Amante DeCastro and Charles and James Sommer. He is also survived by siblings Donald DeCastro, Caloy de Castro and Perlas Johr as well as numerous nieces, nephews and many loving relatives. In addition to his parents, Juan & Purificacion DeCastro, he was predeceased by two brothers, Thomas and Manuel. His family was the source of great joy and pride throughout his life, and his memory will live on in the hearts of those he held dear.

A visitation to celebrate Dr. Amante DeCastro's life will be held at the Adams Funeral Home, 64 Broad Street, Woodstown, New Jersey 08098, on Tuesday, December 5, 2023 from 6:30pm - 8:30pm and Wednesday, December 6, 2023 from 9:30am - 10:30am at St. Gabriel the Archangel Parish, 369 Georgetown Road, Carney's Point, New Jersey 08069, with mass to follow at 11am. 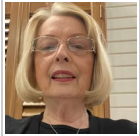
