Andrew Peter Mastella, Jr., age 73, currently living in Pennsville, NJ, passed away on February 20, 2023. Born in Philadelphia, PA, he was the son of the late Andrew Peter Mastella, Sr. and Cecelia (Schenk) Mastella. Andrew grew up in Richwood, NJ, was a graduate of Clearview High School and he went on to earn his Associate's Degree in Criminal Justice from Gloucester County Community College. In 1978, he was married to Andrea Annanie, the mother of his two daughters, Milissa and Alexa, and he would move to Salem County. Andrew was employed as a State Trooper by the New Jersey State Police for 27 years from which he retired in 2000 holding the rank of Sergeant First Class. After his retirement from the State Police, he ran MPI in Woodstown until 2013, working as a private investigator. Andrew then moved to Florida for several years, returning recently to Salem County to be closer to family. Andrew enjoyed golfing, playing Blackjack at the Golden Nugget and was an avid Philadelphia sports fan. He loved cooking and eating Italian food and a high point of his day was getting that cup of hazelnut coffee from Wawa.

Andrew is survived by his daughters Milissa Mastella and Alexa Mastella, their mother Andrea Mastella, his grandson Jameson Mastella and his beloved German Shepherd Santino. He was predeceased by his parents.
