Angelo Giova, age 91, of Penns Grove, NJ passed away peacefully at home surrounded by his family on Friday, June 21, 2024. Born in Philadelphia, PA, Angelo was the son of the late Felice and Anna Giovannangelo. He was predeceased by his son Felix in 2014. Angelo was the last surviving member of his family and was predeceased by brothers Thomas, Felix, Nicholas and sisters Mary, Eva, Anna, Josephine and Gilda.

Angelo was a graduate of South Philadelphia High School Class of 1950. He served in the US Army Anti-Aircraft Artillery Division from 1953-1955 and received a Proclamation and the Salem County Military Medal for Honorable Service by the US House of Representatives. Angelo was employed by Avon Products in Newark, DE as an accountant and retired in 1988 after 32 years. He was a member of the Knights of St. Gabriel and the Mother of Grace Lodge. Angelo loved bowling and golfing as well. In 1972, he bowled a perfect game (300) and was acknowledged by the American Bowling Congress and received the iconic bowling ring. Although he enjoyed golf, he really treasured the camaraderie he shared with his foursome. Angelo had a smile for everyone he met but his greatest joy was being with his family.

Angelo is survived by his loving wife of 68 years, Helen (Pomponi), daughters Elena Vignola (Steve), Anne Giova-Rainey (Robert) and daughter-in-law Kimberly Giova. He is also survived by grandchildren Stephanie Pitts (Gary),
