Anna Rose Ficcadenti, 97, of Carneys Point, NJ passed away on Friday, October 23, 2020. She was born January 10, 1923, in Roseto, Pennsylvania, the daughter of the late Vito and Antonette Romano.

Anna was a 1940 graduate of Penns Grove High School and went on to work for the Pennsylvania Reading Railroad in a secretarial clerical position. In 1946, she married Vito Ficcadenti, settled down and started her family in Penns Grove.

Anna was a member of St. Gabriel the Archangel parish and longtime member of St. James RC Church. She was active in many organizations in St. James Parish: St. James Altar and Rosary Society (past treasurer), Parish Council, the Senior Saints, Mother of Grace Society and the Senior Choir and Cantata Choir. Anna also volunteered her time as chair of the Penns Grove HS 1940 Class Reunions.

Anna is survived by her daughters Judith Perlmutter (Martin) of Houston, TX and Carol Klessel (Dave) of Pennsville; her grandchildren Stefanie Klessel, Judy Flitcraft, Brian Perlmutter and Allison Perlmutter; her great grandchildren Madison, Gabriel and Grace Flitcraft; and many nieces and nephews. In addition to her parents, she was predeceased by her husband Vito Ficcadenti and her siblings Cecelia Pomponi and Peter Romano.
