AJ served as a Councilman, one year as Council President. Prior to his years on Council, AJ was appointed as Borough Solicitor. He served on the Salem Community College Board of Trustees, the Board of Directors for Meals On Wheels as well as the Foundation for the Salem County Vo-Tech. Past President of the Salem County Bar Association and member of the Salem County Human Relations Advisory Board. A big sports fan, he loved watching the 76ers, Phillies and the Eagles with his brother David.

AJ is survived by his mother Marjorie, his brother David, a cousin Joe Santagrossi (Sherry) as well as many other family members and friends. His father, Anthony Sr., predeceased him.
