Anthony John Maniglia, 96, of Carney's Point, NJ passed away peacefully on June 26, 2023 surrounded by his family.

Anthony (Tony) was born in Altoona, PA to the late Stefano and Giuseppa (Fucca) Maniglia. He married Phyllis (Jorkasky) Maniglia on Thanksgiving Day, 1953. They then moved to New Jersey which was the start of nearly 70 wonderful years together.

Tony was a 1945 graduate of Altoona High School. He served in the US Army from 1945-1947 and was stationed in Germany during World War II. He graduated from St. Francis College in Loretto, PA in 1952 and began a teaching career that spanned 37 years in the Penns Grove-Carneys Point School District as a history and social studies teacher. He received a master's degree from Glassboro State College in 1972 and became the Penns Grove Middle School Librarian. He was awarded the New Jersey Governor's Award for Outstanding Teachers. He also worked at Flowers by Ford as a delivery driver after school and on weekends and in the summer painted for the school district.

Tony was a member of St. Gabriel the Archangel Parish. He was a devoted Catholic, attended mass and volunteered with many church events through the years. He was a member of the Mother of Grace Lodge where he served

as Treasurer and the Washington Club where he served as President. He was a member of the New Jersey Education Association.

He was active in family life and loved to travel on family vacations. He loved the beaches of Cape May, NJ and the Outer Banks of NC. His travels later in life took him and his beloved wife to Hawaii, Italy and Ireland. He enjoyed golf and landed a hole in one at Waynesboro Country Club. He excelled at calligraphy, creating beautiful invitations through the years. What he most enjoyed was trying to tell a good joke. He often laughed so hard that he couldn't finish the punchline which in itself was the funniest part. He often ran into former students which was always a highlight of his day.

After a lifetime of love, he was predeceased by his wife, Phyllis, by 29 days. He was also predeceased by his parents and three siblings- Angelo (Mary); Pete (Irene) and Helen and in-laws Sigmund and Rose Jorkasky, Eugene Jorkasky, Helen Benton (Kenneth); Dorothy Sagaities (Alex); Therese McClain (Charles); Patricia Wertner (Joseph); and Marie O'Leary (Timothy)
