Anthony "Tony" Pogozeleski, 88, of Woodstown passed away on February 14, 2013. Born in Glen Cove, NY, Mr. Pogozeleski was the son of Anthony & Hedwig (Strauss) Pogorzelski. He was a member of St. Joseph's R.C. Church, The Catholic Community of the Holy Spirit, and former member and Eucharistic Minister of Saint Mary of the Lakes, Medford, NJ.
