Tony graduated from Brown Technical in 1966 receiving a degree in mechanical engineering. Soon thereafter he began working at Westinghouse and then he moved on to Stone & Webster in Cherry Hill where he worked as a mechanical engineer. He worked there for several years until they laid him off. Although it was a very tough time, Tony made the decision to start working in the insurance industry and embarked on what would become an illustrious career. As a broker, Anthony F.
