



Antoinette "Toni" DeAngelis

Antoinette "Toni" Frolio DeAngelis, 93, of Pittsgrove, NJ (recently Shrewsbury) passed away peacefully on December 24, 2025 surrounded by family.

Born in Bridgeton, New Jersey, Toni graduated valedictorian of Bridgeton High School in 1950.

On November 22, 1956, she married Charles J. DeAngelis, the love of her life. Together they built Charlie's business as a stone-mason and contractor. For 56 years they were true partners in business and in life until his death in 2012.

Toni worked for many years at Bell Telephone Company before becoming a full-time wife and mother. She returned to the workforce in 1975 as the Municipal Court Clerk and Administrator for Pittsgrove Township. She truly loved her work in Pittsgrove, remaining in the position for almost 20 years. The courthouse was the heartbeat of the township, and Toni kept her finger firmly on its pulse. She ran the court with efficiency and fairness and built lasting friendships throughout the community.

A lifelong and deeply devoted Catholic, Toni served for decades as a Eucharistic Minister and Lector at St. Francis of Assisi Church (now Divine Mercy Parish) in Vineland.

She was a doting mother, grandmother, and great grandmother, finding immense joy in spending time with her grandchildren and great grandchildren. She was also a loving aunt to her many nieces and nephews, staying close with them through her final years.

Toni was predeceased by her parents, John J. and Mary (Fanigliulo) Frolio; her sister Jean Vasjuta; her brothers Anthony and John Frolio; and her beloved husband Charles.

She is survived by her daughter Donna and son-in-law Francis White; her grandchildren Devin and Allison (Straw) White and Kelli (White) Gilbreath; her great-grandchildren Shepherd White and Neil and Owen Gilbreath; as well as a close circle of nieces, nephews, and loyal friends.

The family wishes to express heartfelt gratitude for the unwavering love and support shown to Toni over the years—especially to her devoted nieces and nephews who were always there for her; to her son-in-law Francis White, who cherished her deeply; to the entire White family; to the many steadfast friends who remained close through every season of her life; and to the caring community of St. Catharine-St. Margaret Parish and St. Catharine School for their prayers, kindness and support in her later years.
