Antonio J. Garbini, 93, of Pennsville passed away on August 26, 2015 surrounded by his loving family. Born in West Virginia, Mr. Garbini was the son of Alessandro & Maria (Santori) Garbini. Tony is survived by his long time companion, Margaret "Peggy" Haines, his children; Robert Garbini and his wife, Julie; Dennis Garbini and his wife, Diane; Susan Lagrotteria and her husband, Joseph; his siblings; Clara Clemente, Emo J. Garbini and Delfo Garbini and eight grandchildren; Thatcher, Grayson, Nicholas, Alessandra, Dawn (Chad), Daill, Emily (Christopher) and Carly; and great grand-daughter, Alexa, Tony also leaves Peggy's daughter; Mary McTague and her husband Edward, their two children; Edward and Lauren as well as Peggy's son, Donald C. Four words that describe Tony are "a quiet man with a big heart." These words not only describe who he was but what Tony was about throughout his life. Family and friends were extremely important to Tony and he would do anything for them and he would not turn anyone away if they needed help. Known as the "fix-it man", Tony could repair anything and everything that you brought to him. No matter how big or small. Tony also loved working with wood and he was a true craftsman.

After high school, he was drafted by the Philadelphia Athletics and was playing in the minor league system until the war started. Like most young men of the era, Tony joined the military and would spend the next three years, 1942- 1945 with the 82nd Airborne. After returning home from the war, he resumed working at DuPont Chamber Works retiring as a chemist supervisor in the GAL Lab. Tony also helped in the construction of the annex for Corpus Christi Church and the American Red Cross office in Carney's Point. Prior to his retirement and more so afterwards, Tony enjoyed working in his yard. He would spend hours bringing it to perfection and it did not go unnoticed.
