Her creativity drew her straight into the drama department while in middle school where she starred in performances of Oklahoma, High School Musical, and Into the Woods.

Academically she thrived and at the end of her middle school career, she earned the prestigious recognition of salutatorian. While in high school, she honed the skills that she had acquired and continued to participate in theatrical productions such as “Wicked.”

She took her talents out into the sports arena and participated in softball, a game that she enjoyed playing and learning with her brothers.

She was active in her service to the church and assisted wherever she could. Since a young age, April worked among many, holding several positions to care for and help others, while developing lifelong bonds during her time spent with those at Saint James, Emmanuel Full Gospel Church of God in Christ, and Holloway Memorial. Not ever desiring to be in the forefront, she embraced her position in the background and helped with any and everything she could: praise and worship, scripture readings, prayer, choir, programming and more. Truly, the catalyst behind the shine of April's life was her immense and immeasurable amount of love, one that only God could truly give.

April is a beloved member of her family who will never be replaced. 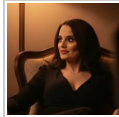

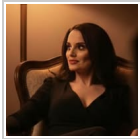
