Arline Ann Popick Field, 80, passed away on March 1, 2015 at her home in Carney's Point, NJ surrounded by family.

Arline was a loving and devoted wife, mother, and grandmother. Her survivors include her husband of fifty-seven years, Dr. James B. Field. Her four children, James Field (Ryan), Margaret Giacalone, Mark Field, and Stanley Field. Her daughter-in-law, Melissa Field, and son-in-laws Nino Marchesani and Dr. John Giacalone, six grandchildren, Dr. John Michael Giacalone, Dr. Joseph Giacalone, Margaret Giacalone, Michael Field, Matthew Field, and Isabella Field and other family members Traci Armentani and Karin Arway.

Born in Newark, NJ to Stanley and Anna Popick, Arline was predeceased by a brother, William Popick. She graduated with a BS degree from New Jersey State University, and an MS in counseling from Rowan University. She worked four years for the East Orange, NJ School System, and 27 years in the Penns Grove-Carney's Point School System, beginning as a sixth grade teacher at the Broad Street School, and retiring as a Guidance Counselor at Penns Grove High School. She was an active member of the National Education Association (NEA), member of the New Jersey Retiree Education Association (NJREA), a 50 year member of The American Association of University Women (AAUW), twice President of the Salem County branch and President and Vice President of Salem County Retired Educators Association.

In addition, her social memberships included Penns Grove Women's Club and Queen Mother of The Red Hat Society. She was a member and chairperson for the Salem County Board of Mental Health, the Office on Aging Transportation System Committee, and the St. James High School Mothers Club. As an active member of the St. Gabriel Archangel Roman Catholic Church, she was a member and past president of the Altar and Rosary Society. In 2007, she was a recipient of The Salem County Commission on Women's Woman of Achievement Award. She also belonged to the Salem County Historical Society, the PG-CP Historical Society and the Senior Circle of Salem Memorial Hospital.

In her spare time, Arline loved the arts and studied various techniques. She devoted a great deal of her time to painting portraits and landscapes in water color, acrylic, and oils. She was the recipient of several awards for her paintings, and belonged to The Salem County Art Group. One of the things she loved most was singing in a choir with the Salem County Oak Singers.
