For many years, they served in the community as youth leaders of Seed of Abraham Ministries and advisors to the Fellowship of Christian Athletes, Baccalaureate, and Rotary International's Interact youth community service club. During her retirement, she enjoyed spending time with family, going to the movies and family trips to Disney World, and playing with her grandson.

She was a gentle, strong and wise woman, the best of friends, a talented painter and calligrapher, a spiritual mother to many, and a faithful disciple of Christ whose life was an inspiring testimony of grace and selfless service to others. 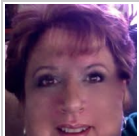

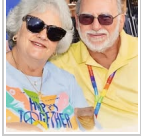
