Bernard R Kompa, 85, of the NJ Veteran's Memorial Home, passed away on November 17, 2020. He was born in Reading, PA on June 22, 1935 and was the son of Raymond & Stella (Oberc) Kompa. He graduated from Reading High School and went on to earn his Bachelor's of Engineering degree at the United States Naval Academy, graduating in 1957. He then served several years in the Air Force Reserves as a 1st Lieutenant. Bernie later earned a Master's in Business Administration from Widener University. He traveled extensively both domestically and internationally for his engineering career which spanned several decades with Westinghouse Corporation. He later took up a new career as a stockbroker in his retirement years. As Bernie liked to keep himself busy, he also taught Russian language courses part-time at a university in his early years.

Bernie lived in his beloved township of Pilesgrove for over 41 years and was an active member of The Catholic Community of the Holy Spirit.

He was predeceased by his parents, his wife, Janice Kompa who passed in 2016, his brother Edwin Kompa, sister Dorothy Reimert, and his son Craig Kompa.
