Betty Anne Cassaday (Knabe), 84, of Monroeville, went home to the loving arms of her Lord and Savior on Sunday, July 16, 2023 after a long battle with Alzheimer's Disease. She passed away peacefully at her home surrounded by family.

Betty was born on January 7, 1939, to George and Lelia Knabe. She grew up with her six older siblings in Clarksboro. In her teens, Betty's family moved to Pittsgrove where she attended and graduated from Bridgeton High School where she was an avid softball player. Upon graduation, Betty entered the workforce as a bookkeeper for Seabrook Farms.

During an outing to the local roller-skating rink, Betty met the love of her life, George W. Cassaday Sr. After several years of dating and upon the return of George from overseas Military Duty, they were married on November 15, 1958 at the Ferrell United Methodist Church.

A few years after their marriage, George and Betty gave their life over to Christ. Betty was a member of the First Baptist Church of Elmer, faithfully attending for over forty years. Serving the Lord as financial secretary, providing hospitality to visiting missionaries, youth group leader and using her services wherever needed.

After starting a family, Betty worked tirelessly as wife, mother, homemaker and bookkeeper for George's family farm in Monroeville. She hosted many family events and enjoyed spending quality time with them. She faithfully worked by George's side for the next fifty years before retiring from all her secretarial duties at Cassaday Farms in 2010.

Before Alzheimer's robbed Betty of her memory, she and George spent their winter months in Florida with daily walks on the beach, playing cards, relaxing and watching the NCAA games cheering on their favorite basketball team Duke University. She loved working in her yard: cutting grass, planting flowers and designing her landscape in which she took such pride and joy.

Betty is survived by her three children, Karen (Bryan) Malik of Colorado, George (Christy) Cassaday Jr. of Monroeville and Rebecca (Mark) Raymond of Upper Township; seven grandchildren, Katelyn and Kristin Malik, George III, Cody and Clay Cassaday, Faith (Matthew) Leonetti and Lia Raymond. Betty was predeceased by her husband George in 2016.
