Brian Keith Light, 55, of Pennsville, NJ passed away suddenly on December 22, 2018. Born in Salem, he was the son of Alfred J. (Jack) and Carol (Downs) Light of Carneys Point. Brian was a 1981 graduate of Penns Grove High School where he played on the football team for all four years (as well as baseball and golf). Forever dedicated to Penns Grove's football program, "Coach Light" assisted with the team and was there when they won their state championship in 2012. In 1987, Brian earned a Bachelor's Degree in Marketing from the Wharton School at the University of Pennsylvania.

Brian worked at the DuPont Experimental Station and Barley Mill Plaza in Wilmington, DE for 15 years. After that he was self-employed, working on security systems and equipment and would ultimately work as a financial analyst for the Delaware City Refinery. Brian was an avid Eagles and Phillies fan, enjoyed photography and home brewing and was the President of the Tri-State Home Brewing Association. He had a great love of music and would follow many bands, documenting his experiences through photos and videos. Brian and Trisha spent their honeymoon in Key West, FL and would return there faithfully almost every year of their 21 years of marriage. They also spent many celebratory weekends in Sea Isle City, NJ and Rehoboth Beach, DE where they made so many fond memories with their friends who remember him as having a heart of gold and being a mediator, fun-loving, generous, and as the man behind the camera who always had the biggest

smile in any room.

In addition to his parents, Brian is survived by his loving wife Trisha M. (Curran) Light; his brother, John Light of San Francisco, CA; his sister, Cynthia Pistritto and her husband Sebastian of West Chester, PA; his nephews and niece Matthew, Daniel and Katherine Pistritto; many aunts, uncles, cousins, brothers and sisters in law, nieces, nephews and friends; and his faithful furry children, JoPa and Fins.
