Carleton Dale Smith ("Smitty"), 78, of Aldine passed away peacefully on April 26, 2024. Born in Woodbury, Dale was the twin son of Carlton & Myra Kessler Smith. Raised in his beloved hometown of Aldine and a graduate of Woodstown High School, Dale was a lover of the simple life and took great pride in his farm and the township to which he belonged. Dale began working as a 3rd generation dairy farmer at the age of 13 and was co-owner of the Triangle Dairy Farm with his twin brother, Donn. Tending to the farm may have been a 24-hour job, but he always found time to serve his community and those people and organizations he loved. While Dale served as Mayor of Alloway Township for multiple terms, he also served on the Alloway Township Board as well as their Planning Committee. He was recognized for registering 800 dogs during his time served. He was a former member of the Alloway Fire Company and the Ambulance Corp., serving as its Treasurer. He served on the Alloway Parade Committee, Alloway Veterans Association, and also served as an officer in the Alloway Police Department, proudly still showcasing his badge until the end. Dale was also a member of the Alloway 4-H Club and showed his many cows in both the Salem and Cumberland County Fairs. He was a member of the Aldine UMC Church, the Landowners Deer Club, and was an avid sports fan, dedicating much of his time to keeping up with every Phillies and Eagles game known to mankind. Dale was known as the, "Aldine Bookie," enthusiastically selling and promoting tickets for various organizations. Dale was also notorious for his tremendous generosity

in the community and willingness to help others, no matter their circumstances. Dale not only watched sports, but he also played in the local softball league and drove for BR Williams. He was also a lover of wildlife, was an avid hunter, and could often be seen hunting on his farm from his truck in his later years. Lastly, one of his greatest joys could be found in noticing what flowers had bloomed and keeping a careful watch on how the crops were faring throughout the growing season/s.

Dale is survived by his wife Judith (nee: Hennis); two step/bonus children, Jaime Ladd and her husband Roger and Brandon Henry and his wife Jennifer; twin brother, Donn and his wife Jackie; four grandchildren, Rivers, Wilder Dale, Remington Rose, and Parker in addition to nieces and nephews, Janine (Joe), Steven, Michelle, Connor, McKenzie, Jackson, Waylon, Abby, Autumn, Kate, Clarke and Lillie.
