



## Charles E. Baum Jr.

Charles E. Baum, Jr., 74, of Woodstown, died peacefully on Saturday, June 2, 2018 at his home with his wife of 48 years by his side. “Charlie” was born in Woodbury and was raised in Woodstown. Charlie graduated from Woodstown High School in 1961. He attended Rutgers University on an ROTC Scholarship. After graduating in 1965, Charlie attended Army Officer training and, in 1966, was deployed to Vietnam. His service in Vietnam earned him the rank of Captain and the Bronze Star. After fulfilling his commitment to the Army, Charlie returned home to Woodstown. He was hired by the DuPont Company, serving as a regional manager, national manager and international manager until he retired in 1997.

Charlie helped serve his community in many ways. He was a member of Borough Council, helped found the Woodstown Boosters Club, the Mini Wrestlers League and the Marlton Recreation Association. He was on the DAT team for the American Red Cross and worked for them in Louisiana after Hurricane Katrina. He was a volunteer and board member for Habitat for Humanity in Salem County. He served as an administrator for the Woodstown Moose and was a board member of the Woodstown-Pilesgrove Library Association.

Charlie is survived by his wife Susan, children Katie DiDio (Rob), Charles III “Tripp” (Jess), Julie Smythe (Tony), grandchildren Maddie and Ben DiDio,

Nathan Baum, Zoe, Parker, Lila and Carson Smythe. Sisters Carol Tighe (Ralph) and Linda Baum (Martin Zell), many nieces and nephews and good friends Frosty Ray and Greekgarious Greg who were always there for him. He was predeceased by his parents Charles E. and Stella (Jarrell) Baum and his nephew, Spc. Richard C. Emmons III.
