Charles James Puff, age 81, of Elmer, NJ passed away on January 6, 2024. Born in Santa Barbara, California, but raised most of his life in Santa Monica, he was the son of the late Alfred and Gertrude (Walsh) Puff.

After graduating from Santa Monica High School, he joined the United States Air Force, stationed at Dover Air Force Base as a fireman in Crash and Rescue. Upon his honorable discharge in February 1966, he worked in several positions in the newspaper and advertising fields, both in California and New Jersey. At one point he owned his own advertising business. He worked for H.M. Davis in Shiloh, NJ, RAM Motors in Chester, PA and Bartlett Bearing in Philadelphia. His final job, prior to his retirement was Purchasing Manager at Clement Pappas / Lousande in Seabrook and Carneys Point.

Although a late comer to the game, he loved playing golf with his friends.

For several years, he was a member and a past president of Elmer Rotary, he served on the Planning Board of Elmer and was a volunteer for Fort Mott National Park.

He was a man of faith, attending Elmer Presbyterian Church. He was an Elder for many years. In that capacity he managed the buildings and grounds for the church, maintaining Covid-19 protocols and working in getting updated tech

and services in the church.

He is survived by his loving wife Rebecca (Westcott-Biggs) Puff of 37 years. His son Christopher Puff (Kathy) of Acton, Massachusetts and their children Ryan, Jake and Connor. His step daughters (although "daughters" is the term he always used): Michelle Miller (Biggs) and her son Alex and Jennifer Dillon (Biggs) and her children Isaiah, Teagan and Aubrey. Also Christopher's mother Judith of Shiloh and many friends and family.

Services will be held on Monday, January 15, 2024 at Elmer Presbyterian Church, 107 Chestnut Street, Elmer, NJ 08318. There will be a visitation starting at 10 AM leading to the funeral service at 11 AM. Interment will follow the service at Chestnut Grove Cemetery in Elmer, NJ
