Charles M. Slusser, Sr., age 84, of Carney's Point, passed away quietly at his home on Saturday, April 11, 2015. Charles was formerly employed as an Operator of the MLDW Unit at the Mobil Oil Refinery in Paulsboro, NJ for over 20 years. He served with the U.S. Army, 2nd Infantry Division as a Sergeant First Class Regular Army and was in combat during the Korean War.
