Clarence Michael Hug, age 60, of Monroeville, NJ passed away on Tuesday, January 28, 2020. Born in Fort Wayne, IN, he was the son of Clarence Joseph Hug and Sheila (Smith) Stucker.

When Mike was very young, his family moved to Leonardo, NJ where he grew up. When he was finished high school, Mike moved to Fort Lauderdale, FL then relocated to San Diego, CA where he met his future wife, Suzanne Wambold and the two were wed in 1984.
