Clarence "Pete" Wells, 74, of Pedricktown passed away on May 27, 2013. Born in Mannington, Pete was the son of the late Wayne & Delores Watson Wells. As you will see Pete dedicated his life to his community and country. He retired from the Delaware River Port Authority as a Patrolman after thirty-two years of service. During this time, he also served as a patrolman for Oldmans Township and as its Chief for a period of time. Furthermore, he spent time in the U.S. Army most notably serving during Desert Storm. He also volunteered during the basketball games at the elementary school in Pedricktown doing whatever he could to help out. He was a member of the Hudson United Methodist Church and the FOP, Penn-Jersey Lodge #30. He was very proud of his fellow officers and being part of that Brotherhood as well as supporting his country and its flag.

Pete loved working in the yard and keeping it meticulous but what he enjoyed the most was putting a lawn chair up and having his neighbors stop by for a chat or taking a snooze. By 6 AM every morning he was up and drove down to TC'S Rod Shop for coffee and he always looked forward for the neighborhood kids to stop by for an icy pop. Finally, giving himself and the family a brake from the seriousness of his job, he loved going to Disney World and searching Mickey out.

He survived by his wife Linda, his son David Welch and his wife Crystal of

West Virginia, daughter-in-law, Belinda, cousin (whom he really considered a sister), Carol Simpkins of MD and six grandchildren, Anthony Welch, Kasey Welch, Rodney Welch Jr., Kayla Hancock, Kyle Hancock and Kara Hancock. In addition to his parents, his son Rodney Welch Sr. and a sister Barbara J. Coyle predeceased him.
