Curtis R. Coughlin, 70, of Pittsgrove, passed away on March 19, 2026. Born in Camden, NJ, he was the son of Charles B. Coughlin Jr. and Constance (née King) Coughlin.

Curtis was a graduate of Haddonfield High School and went on to build a long and dedicated career in trucking. He owned and operated his own trucking company, CTC in Newfield, before later retiring from Penske Trucking.

Curtis led a very full life, and his fondest memories include coaching his children in Elmer Little League, playing softball for his church teams, and traveling with family and friends. He was a man of strong faith and active in his Church. He was a current member of Country Road Bible Church and had previously attended Elmer Baptist.
