D. Stuart Cline, 76, of Pennsville passed away on May 26, 2019. Born in Salem, Stu was the son of Donald & Emma Lashley Cline. Stuart graduated from Pennsville Memorial High School, Class of 1960. He was a member of the marching band and the wrestling team, taking 1st place in his weight class in the South Jersey finals and later, 2nd place in the NJ State finals. He continued his education at Salem County Vocational-Technical School with a degree in Electrical Engineering which led him to positions in industry in Delaware, Xerox in NY and for the U.S. Army developing a special patented solenoid for Army tanks built by Chrysler. Stu enjoyed contract work for M & M Mars, Anchor Hocking Glass for Avon and other companies developing more efficient methods and troubleshooting electrical problems on the production lines. Stu returned to Pennsville, becoming self-employed, thus establishing his 40 year career as Stu Cline Auto Electronics. He built a reputation for highly skilled installations for after-market auto stereo sound systems, car alarm systems, remote starts, backup cameras, hidden cameras and more including national auto sound competitions. He maintained a great number of loyal customers who became friends based on his integrity, honesty, a high degree of knowledge and skill, his attention to detail and use of only quality products.

Stuart believed in service to country. He served in the US Army in the mid-1960s and continued his service with the National Guard. Most important to

Stu was his walk with the Lord. He graduated from Elim Bible College in NY in 1975. He served and honored God with his faithfulness sharing the Plan of Salvation. He was involved with sharing the teachings of the Bible with the Bible Study group, the senior Sunday School class and running the projection booth for Sunday services also troubleshooting any electrical issues at First Assembly of God Church.. Stu was thrilled to mentor the younger generation in business, in serving God or in navigating life in general.

He is survived by sister, Stephanie Louise Thibault of Flint, MI, nephews Timothy Thibault of Flint, MI, David Thibault of Alexandria, VA, niece Susan Shaw (Jamie) of Fenton, MI, grand nieces Katie Shaw of NYC, NY, Sarah Shaw of Chicago, IL, Grace Shaw of Fenton, MI and grand nephew Christopher Shaw of Grand Rapids, MI. There are several very special cousins, Cinda Lewis (Phil), Patricia Mayhew (Jay), Connie Reynolds and family and many friends who he cherished.
