



## Dallas "Jack" Bobbitt Sr.

In the presence of his family and in the arms of the Lord, Dallas "Jack" Bobbitt, Sr. passed away on January 14, 2013. Born in Henderson, NC, in 1926, Jack was the son of Gollar Francis & Sophie (Ham) Bobbitt. He left school to work at Edgemont Iron to support the family. Jack was then drafted into the U.S. Army and served his country faithfully for two years during the Second World War. When the war ended he began working for Atlantic City Electric for the next eleven years. After leaving the electric plant in Pennsville, along with his brother John they began working for Star Ford in Penns Grove. Soon there after the two of them realized the benefits of owning their own business and within two years opened their own car dealership in 1959. Until his retirement, Mr. Bobbitt and his brother would work long and hard creating a successful business that was a pillar of our community.

Over the years he was a faithful member of Sharptown United Methodist Church but more importantly he was very devoted and faithful to his heavenly father. Spreading the word was extremely important to him and he considered himself and was thought of as a "Soldier for Jesus". Along with his brother, the two of them started a bible study in their show room in 1971 that lasted more than thirty years. They would often move the cars out for the people to come in. His ministering also included serving as a lay minister at the church and being very involved with the prison ministry in Camden.

Jack is survived by his loving and caring wife Lois; his children, Bruce Bobbitt (Maureen), Brad Bobbitt (Elise), Barry Bobbitt (Tina), Jill Serody (Scott), Dallas Bobbitt, Jr. (Curt), their mother Jeanne Bobbitt, Elwood Robinson (Lori), Bruce Robinson (Jill) and Lois Jean Robinson; his brother John Bobbitt (Jaci), son-in-law, Mike Graham, twenty grandchildren and fifteen great grandchildren. In addition to his parents, two children, Danny Bobbitt and Sherie Bobbitt Graham, siblings, G.V. Bobbitt, Leonard Wilson, Virginia Bliss and Viola Myers and his daughter-in-law, Sharon Bobbitt predeceased him.

Services will be held this Friday, January 18, 2013 all at the Sharptown United Methodist Church, 24 Church St., Pilesgrove, NJ 08098. The viewing will be held from 9 AM until 12 PM with the service following at 12 PM.
