Dallas Harbeson Skinner, 81 of Woodstown formerly residing in Daretown for forty-eight years, passed away on September 28, 2019. Born in Harrisonville, Dallas was the son of Earl J. & Ella H. Skinner. Growing up in Harrisonville, he graduated from Woodstown High School in 1955. He joined the US Army and was stationed in Germany during the Cold War. After being discharged in 1963, Dallas started working for DuPont Chamber Works, retiring in 1993 from the Freon Area. Soon afterwards, he began consulting for Allstates Tech Services at DuPont and was last employed by Al Floyd and Son Land Surveyors. He loved hunting and fishing and he especially enjoyed going to his second home on Lake Bomoseen, VT. (known as Camp Calling Loon) He and the family spent many summers of pure joy there. As the family grew, he took pleasure in introducing the grand and great grandchildren to the lake. He was very proud of his collection of old post cards and memorabilia of Lake Bomoseen. In addition to the lake and spending time there, he loved to travel, having gone to all fifty states, he returned to visit Germany, Spain, Portugal, the British Isles, Belgium, Amsterdam and Italy . Even while Dallas worked at DuPont all those years, he still remained a farmer at heart.

Dallas was a Life Member of the Daretown Fire Company and a past board member of Salem County Habitat for Humanity. He was also a active member

of the Pittsgrove Presbyterian Church where he served as a trustee for many years as well as the overseer to the cemetery for thirty plus years.

He is survived by his wife Anne (Hitchner), whom he married in 1966; sons, Earl J. (Geri) and Mark R. (Diane), grandsons, Marcus Allen (Jessica) and Andrew Dallas, great grandchildren, Sophia and Lucas Allen and sisters, Barbara Hoglen and Joyce Miller (Richard).

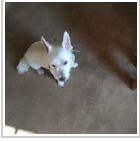
