Diego "Dan" A. Chila, age 73, of Pedricktown, NJ, passed away on March 17, 2021. He is survived by his loving wife of 48 years, Lucille Slattery Chila, his children David (Jill) Chila and Daniel (Bridget) Chila, and his grandchildren Thomas, Alisyn, Julianna, John Francis and Abigail. Dan was predeceased by his parents Dominick and Fortunata Chila of Paulsboro, NJ.

Dan was a resident of Pedricktown for over 45 years. He was a 1966 graduate of St. James High School, Carneys Point, and a 1970 graduate of LaSalle University, Philadelphia, PA. He spent over 40 years as a CPA in banking, retiring in 2009 from Sun National Bank as Chief Financial Officer. Most recently, in his retirement, he worked as Senior Sales Director for F.E. DiBacco Inc., consulting in the banking services industry. Dan was a longstanding member of the American Institute of CPAs and Pennsylvania Institute of CPAs. 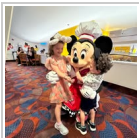
