David Wayne Grasty, 58, of Pedricktown, NJ, passed away on November 23, 2024. He was born in Mannington, NJ, and was the son of the late David and Lorraine Grasty of Carneys Point, NJ. A proud graduate of Penns Grove High School, Class of 1984, Dave continued his education at Salem Community College and Wilmington University, earning a degree in Business Management.

For twenty-five years, Dave worked at Avantor Sciences, where he most recently served as Global Director. He was a devoted Christian and active member of Sharptown Church, where he participated in many ministries, including teaching Bible studies and discipleship classes. His faith was unwavering, and he loved sharing the message of Christ with others.

Dave cherished his family and loved spending time with them, especially on trips to Disney World and Riviera Maya, Mexico. He also had a passion for coaching and mentoring young athletes, earning the nickname "Coach Dave" for his ability to inspire confidence both on and off the field.
