Dean Edward Price, 55, passed away on January 11, 2014. The son of John Edward Price and Phyllis (nee Updike) Pierce, Dean was born in Prince Georges, MD, spent most of his childhood in Titusville, FL, moved to Delaware and spent his remaining years living in Delaware and New Jersey. He graduated from Astronaut High School in 1977 and went on to serve his country as both a marksman and a clarinet player in the Army from 1977 to 1980 and then in the Army National Guard from which he retired in 2011. Dean was a trolley operator for SEPTA in Philadelphia and during his down time, he really enjoyed line dancing at Prospectors in Mt. Laurel. Dean will be remembered as a "big teddy bear" who loved Sci-Fi, riding his motorcycle, and his dogs Suzie, Angel, and Missy.

He is survived by his girlfriend of several years, Jackie Patrick; his daughter, Amanda Price; his grandson, Holden Loose; his mother, Phyllis Pierce; his siblings, Diane Price, Chrystal DeCarlo, Terry Price, Randy Price, Brian Price, and Tommy Price; his stepmother, Pat Price; his stepchildren, Michelle Loper, Amanda Alward, and Michael Alward; as well as several nieces, nephews, and stepgrandchildren.
