Dennis "Duke" Duchesne, 62, of Carney's Point passed away on Thursday, July 12th at his home. Born in Philadelphia, Pa., he was predeceased by his parents Earl L. & Anna Duchesne of Toms River NJ and his sister Joan E. Miedwig of Layfayette Hill, Pa.
