Rev. Donald R. Ball of Pennsville passed away on April 21, 2018. Born in West Virginia, Rev. Ball was the son of Earl & Ena Tenney Ball. Throughout his life, Rev. Ball's passion was serving the Lord, spending time with his family and the church. For many years he was the lead pastor for the United Pentecostal Church in Deepwater, now the Deepwater Community Church, which he started in the early 60's. He was also well known for visiting folks while riding his Harley in a three piece suit.
