Donald Allen Stiles, 82, of Mannington passed away on August 17, 2023. Born on March 16, 1941 to George & Dorothy Stiles, he was one of seven children and grew up in LAC. He graduated from Salem High School in 1958 and worked at the Salem A&P while attending Goldey Beacom College graduating in 1961.

Don started working at DuPont Chamber Works in the accounting department in 1962 which was also the same year he met his future wife, Lynne. During his time there he worked his way up to be the supervisor of the department. In 1963, he joined the US Army and was stationed at Fort Lee in Virginia until 1965. After serving his country, Mr. Stiles went back to work at DuPonts. In 1984, he left Duponts to become the CEO of the Deepwater Industries Federal Credit Union after serving many years as the volunteer treasurer. During his tenure a new office building was constructed in Deepwater. Don would eventually retire from the Credit Union in 2003. In addition to working at the Credit Union, Don also served as the tax collector for Mannington, having worked there for forty-four years before retiring from there as well. In addition to all this, Mr. Stiles also enjoyed spending time in Sea Isle City, going on cruises and going to the casinos. Finally, he was an active member of Haines Neck UMC and the Mannington Ruritan Club for many years.

He is survived by his wife of fifty-six years, Lynne (Hendrickson); his children,

Noelle and her husband Andy Hill of Alloway and Kevin and his wife Colleen Stiles of Harpers Ferry, WV; two grandsons, Nicholas and Logan Hill, a sister-in-law, Beryl Almond, brothers-in-law, Joe Almond, Lee Lark and Jim Renzi, a brother-in-law and sister-in-law, Don & Dee Hendrickson as well as many nieces and nephews. Don was predeceased by his parents, his brothers, George and Larry Stiles and sisters, June Rankin, Dorothy Nestor, Loretta Lark and Peggy Renzi.
