Edward J. Incollingo, Sr. 88, of Pilesgrove passed away on January 29, 2024. Born in Philadelphia, Mr. Incollingo was the son of Edward M. and Rose (nee: Calviello) Incollingo. Prior to purchasing the Penns Grove IGA, which became known as Incollingo's Family Market, in 1983, he began his career working for Food Fair which was later known as Pantry Pride. In 1961 he became the store manager in the Philadelphia Region and continued to work his way up to Vice President of Operations in the Miami Region. After purchasing the IGA in Penns Grove, the store would remain as a community fixture and family business for the next thirty-nine years. Mr. Incollingo also served in the US Army from 1956-1958.

He is survived by his children Edward Jr. and his wife Linda, Patricia Cardoso and her husband Joseph, Mario and his wife Veronica and Joseph Incollingo; his grandchildren, Vincent (Cerissa), April (Steve) Eddie (Ashley), Mario Jr., Justin (Roger), Nicholas (Sara), Paige (Eric), Anthony (Peyton), Kate (Dewey), Danielle (Steve) and Joseph as well as twenty great grandchildren and one more on the way.
