Edwin Terry, 84, of Carneys Point passed away on October 8, 2013. Ed was born in Carneys Point and has resided there all his life. He was the son of Roy B. & Anna T. (Murray) Terry. He retired from DuPont Chamber Works after twenty-one years in 1971 and soon thereafter began working as a dispatcher for Carneys Point Police. Ed graduated from Penns Grove High School in 1949. However, he was suppose to have graduated in 1946 but left school after joining the U.S. Army to serve in WWII. Mr. Terry would eventually join the U.S. Navy as well during the Korean War. He was the longest serving active Charter member of the Carneys Point Fire Department. Over the years he has held several offices, including, President of the Exempt Fireman's Association, which he is now the Vice President, Treasurer of the Department and an exempt fireman himself. Ed has been recognized over the years for his dedicated service to both the department and the community. He was recognized by the Township for fifty years of service as well as being named the Fireman of the Year. When he was not at the hall, he loved fishing, crabbing, doing some woodwork and taking a ride over to Delaware Park. Mr. Terry was also a long time member of Corpus Christi R.C. Church which is now part of St. Gabriel the Arch Angel Parish.

He is survived by his daughter, Diane Scott and her husband Charles, sons, Robert Terry and his wife Kathleen, Michael Terry and his wife Erin and Joseph Terry and his wife Patricia, twelve grandchildren and eight great

grandchildren. In addition to his parents, his wife Virginia Evelyn Terry and siblings, Dorothy Nichols, Roy B. Terry, Jr., Margaret Reardon and John R. Terry predeceased him.

A viewing will be held on Friday night, October 11, 2013 at the Carneys Point Fire Department, 258 D Street, Carneys Point from 6 until 8 PM and again Saturday morning, October 12 at the hall, starting at 9 AM. A Mass of Christian Burial will be offered following the Saturday morning visitation at The Parish of St. Gabriel the Arch Angel, 369 Georgetown Rd., Carneys Point, NJ, 08069 at 11 AM. Interment will take place at St. Joseph's Cemetery in Woodstown.
