On December 23, 2009, Elbridge Bostwick, 80, of Elmer went home to be with his Savior and Lord. Born in Elmer, Mr. Bostwick was the son of Eugene W. & Della Bostwick. Bridge was a lifetime resident of Elmer, living in only three houses his whole life. He graduated from Bridgeton High School in 1946 and the Locksmithing Institute in 1970. He worked at E. W. Bostwick Co. from the time he was 12 years old until he retired in 1994, except for his time in the U.S. Army and for the few years he ran Bostwick Fuel Oil Service in the 1950's. Mr. Bostwick was a lifelong member of the Elmer Presbyterian Church serving over the years as Deacon, Trustee, Elder, Clerk of Session and a member of the Choir. At one time, he also served as Sexton. Bridge was also a member of the VFW, Frank D. Sayre Post #1259 and currently serving as the Post Adjutant. After serving on the Zoning Board of Adjustment for 21 years, from 1979 to 2000 he was honored by the Borough of Elmer.

He is survived by his wife of 53 years, Lillian (nee: Black), his children, Donna and her husband Gary Dugan, Garrie and his wife Debbie Bostwick, grandchildren, Brian Wiltsey, Brent Wiltsey, Christopher Bostwick, Daniel Bostwick and Brandon Dugan, the Bostwick brothers and their wives, Dave and Ruth, Blinn and Grace, Herb and Marianne and Leigh and Barbara Bostwick as well as many nieces and nephews. He was predeceased by his

sister Charlotte Bostwick.
