Eleanor "Nanny" Kitchin, 93, of Pilesgrove passed away on July 15, 2023. Born in Camden, Mrs. Kitchin was the daughter of Edwin & Mabel Falls Phillips. After high school, Eleanor began working as a switchboard operator for Bell Telephone Company. She married Harry in 1954, and they spent the next sixty-nine years together. Family was her life, and children were her passion. She loved all children, and had a special fondness for the "ornery" ones. She was always proud to brag about her family. She would say, "Children are a gift, and when God gives you a gift, you brag about it!" Eleanor began working for the Glassboro Public School system in 1963, and retired in 1975 to start a private daycare. She cared for hundreds of children in her home over the next twenty-five years. In 1993, she moved to Pilesgrove, where she continued to share her love in the Sharptown United Methodist Church nursery. The children would patiently wait their turn for shared lap time with Nanny Kitchin. She retired as the nursery attendant at the age of 87. She was known to all, children and adults alike, as Nanny. When introducing herself she always said, "Everyone calls me Nanny." She felt honored to have three family members named after her, one granddaughter and two great-granddaughters. Eleanor was the last surviving sibling of the Phillips family.

She is survived by her husband Harry Kitchin, Sr; two children, Harry "Ted" Kitchin, Jr. and his wife Deneen and Gail Clark and her husband Russ; seven grandchildren, Russ "Chip" Clark Jr. and his wife Dawn, Torey Dunham and

her husband Kenny, Taryn Simmons and her husband Adam, Harry Kitchin III and his wife Kelly, Holly Zane and her husband Eric, Noelle English and her husband Bobby and Shawn Decker and her husband Todd as well as nineteen great grandchildren. In addition to her parents, she was predeceased by three brothers, William, Robert and Elwood Phillips and four sisters, Margaret Behnke, Edna Bakley, Mable Campbell and Helen Huhn.
