Lizzie attended grade schools in Dover AFB, DE, Chanute AFB, Champaign Urbana, IL, Offutt AFB, Omaha, NE, Charlotte, NC, and Woodstown, NJ. After graduating from Woodstown High School, Elizabeth returned to North Carolina to attend Appalachian State University.

Elizabeth was an accomplished and highly respected paralegal specializing in Family Law. Over the past 28 years, Lizzie worked with prestigious law firms in both NJ and PA. Her colleagues and clients describe Elizabeth as a true professional, filled with compassion. She had a gift of making her clients feel heard, guiding them through some of life's most dramatic and challenging moments.

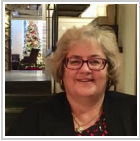
