Elizabeth Boeger Horbach went home to be with her Lord on Sunday, January 15, 2012 after a brief illness at her home in Pittsgrove, New Jersey. Born in 1933 at Pottsville, Pennsylvania, she grew up in Audubon, New Jersey.

She was a dedicated teacher known for her enthusiasm and creativity. She attended Elizabethtown College where she met her future husband. Transferring to Glassboro State College, Elizabeth earned a bachelor's degree in education and a master's degree in reading education before pursuing post-graduate studies in special education at Syracuse University. After teaching at several New Jersey private and public schools she established one of the earliest special education classes in this area at the Elmer Public School.

Elizabeth was a sincere and faithful Christian, an ordained deacon in the Presbyterian Church, who shared in the ministry of her husband. Using her teaching skills and experience she developed a unique, multi-denominational Christian education program for special education children in the Burlington area. A member of Memorial Presbyterian Church for many years, she was actively involved in the life of the congregation until an injury restricted her mobility. She was also a member of Delta Kappa Gamma and the Order of the Eastern Star. For many years she enjoyed collecting, researching and marketing oriental art and antiques with her husband. Elizabeth's laughter was

contagious and her generosity without measure.

Elizabeth is survived by her husband of 56 years, the Rev. Dr. C. Frederick Horbach, her beloved son, Thomas B. Horbach, his beloved wife, Cynthia, and two devoted grandchildren, Victoria H. Stidham and Justin A. Pierce, plus many, many others for whom she was their "Aunt Betty". She was predeceased by her parents Frederick and Irene Boeger.

A time to gather to celebrate her life will be held this Sunday, January 29, 2012 at the Memorial Presbyterian Church, 714 South 7th Street, (7th and Chestnut), Vineland 08360. From 2 PM until 3 PM, Rev. Horbach, Tom and the rest of the family will be available to greet anyone who wishes to stop by and pay their respects with the service following at 3 PM. Interment is private and at the convenience of the family.
