Ella Marie (Green) Belitza, 100 years young, of Carney's Point NJ passed away at her home on Sunday July 14, 2024. She was born on October 30, 1923 in Piper's Gap, VA.

A year after high school, she came to Wilmington DE for work and lived at the YWCA. In 1945 she met and married "Jim" with whom she had five children. In addition to being a Full time homemaker, she played with her children, made clothes for dolls, enjoyed sewing, and loved baking. She must have made a gazillion cookies, pies and cakes. Many stories could be shared about the cook outs which were held in the back woods.

As a member of Cross Point Wesleyan for sixty-seven years, she expressed her love of Jesus as a Sunday school teacher, as an active member of the Women's Missionary Society and a faithful attendee.

John and Ella traveled extensively throughout the U.S. and visited forty-nine states as well as Mexico and Canada. Great memories were made by the children, grandchildren and others who often shared their experiences.
