Emile Frederick Fritz, Jr., 95, of Woodstown passed away on September 14, 2015. Born in Mobile, AL., Mr. Fritz was the son of Emile Sr. & Elizabeth “Mamie” Fritz. He is survived by his wife, Ruth T. (Talbert), children, Charles and his wife Karen, Rob and his wife Linda, David and his wife Alison, Tom and his wife Esther and Kitty and her husband Paul Gerry, as well as thirteen grandchildren.

A World War II veteran, he enlisted in the Army Air Force shortly after the attack on Pearl Harbor in 1941 and served 3 years as a B-17 mechanic.

He was a gifted athlete and played football for Coach Paul “Bear” Bryant at the University of Maryland. He was named an AP honorable mention All-American and was the 115th pick in the 1947 NFL draft. After injuries ended his career, he accepted a position as Agriculture Teacher at Woodstown High School, where he would spend the next 35 years. He led the local chapter of the Future Farmers of America and was active as adult leader for Boy Scout Troop 38, with all four of his son’s achieving Eagle Scout. He and his wife, Ruth, helped to establish St. Luke’s Episcopal Church in Woodstown where they have been long term members. Whether it was through his spirituality or the classroom, he made a difference in the lives of many in the local community.

Services for Mr. Fritz will be held this Saturday, September 19, 2015 at the St. Luke's Episcopal Church, 37 E. Grant St., Woodstown, NJ 08098. The family will be available starting at 9:30 AM to greet anyone who wishes to stop by and pay their respects with the service following at 10:30 AM. Interment is private.
