Emily D. Hewitt, 79, currently residing in Earleville, MD, passed away on April 1, 2026. Born in Wilmington, DE to the late David and Jessie (Browning) Davis, Emily grew up in the Penns Grove / Carneys Point, NJ area and was a 1964 graduate of Penns Grove High School. Later in life, she continued her education by earning a certificate in Administration from the Salem County Vocational Technical School.

Emily began her career working for First Home Savings and Loan, starting out as a Teller and making her way up the ladder to becoming Branch Manager. She also spent time working in the Loan Department after they became Sovereign Bank. When she left the bank, Emily's career shifted and she became the Fugitive Secretary for the Salem County Prosecutor's Office, from which she retired in September of 2022. After Emily's and her husband Wesley's retirement, they turned their summer and weekend getaway home in Earleville, MD into their primary residence.
