



Eugene Williams Sr.

At the age of nineteen a man by the nickname "Tex", Eugene Williams, Sr., moved to Salem County from Texas. He soon began working for DuPont Chamber Works and would eventually retire as a foreman after many years of service. After retiring he joined the DuPont Veterans along with belonging to the Penns Grove Lodge of Free & Accepted Masons as well as the Moose Lodge in Pennsville where he was a lifetime member. He served his country as a Merchant Marine during the Second World War and was a social member of the VFW #8840 in Penns Grove.

Seventy one years later and surrounded by his family, Eugene "Tex" Williams, Sr., 90, passed away on January 29, 2012. He is survived by his sons, Eugene Williams Jr. of Penns Grove and Mark Heritage and his wife Janet of Pennsville; his daughters, Dorothy Wilson and her husband Jim of Arkansas and Jean Roy and her husband Will of Delaware; seventeen grandchildren, twenty-seven great grandchildren and six great great grandchildren. In addition to his parents, C.L. & Georgia Williams, he was predeceased by his two wives, Ruth (Parker) and Margaret (Mars), two daughters, Ruth Eplin and May Heritage as well as being the last of eighteen children born to his parents.
