Floyd Hill of Pittsgrove, New Jersey, passed away on Sunday, October 24, 2021, at the age of 93. After several months of declining health, Floyd died peacefully in his sleep with his beloved wife, Gladys, by his side.

Floyd was born in Hartford, Tennessee on October 5, 1928 to father Charles Hill and mother Barbara Ford Hill. The oldest of four children, Floyd early developed a strong work ethic and a compelling desire to take care of his family, character qualities evident throughout his lifetime. As soon as he was able to enlist, Floyd proudly joined the Navy during World War II and was stationed in Bremerton, Washington until his honorable discharge August 14, 1947.

At the end of his Navy career, Floyd joined his parents who had moved to New Jersey, seeking employment opportunities. Here he met and fell in love with Gladys Cassaday. The two were soon married and, this past July, celebrated 72 years of marriage. Together they raised seven children, settling on a small farm on Route 40 in Pittsgrove. Floyd's favorite job was driving a truck for PDS, Inc. in his retirement from Mobil Oil Company in Paulsboro.

As his large family gathered to reflect on Floyd's life, recurring descriptions of him emerged: a simple man, hard-working, fun-loving, God-honoring, hospitable, happiest with a dining room or backyard filled with his precious

family and friends, dedicated to serving God and his church in many capacities during his life.

Floyd was preceded in death by his parents and by his brother Grover Hill, his sisters Francis Hill Carter and Irene Hill Leatherwood, his son Jerry A. Hill, his daughter Carolyn Hill Griffith, and his granddaughter Renee Garrison Bittle. Several great-grandchildren have also preceded Floyd to Heaven. He is survived by his wife Gladys Cassaday Hill; children Charles (Cheryl) Hill, Kenneth (Eileen) Hill, Grace Green Hill, Glen (Terry) Hill, James (Roberta) Hill, and Annette Hill (Joseph) Kylar; eighteen grandchildren; and 61 surviving great-grandchildren.

A Celebration of Life service for Floyd is planned for Saturday, October 30, 2021, at Calvary Baptist Church, 300 Georgetown Road, Carney's Point, New Jersey 08069. Visitation will be from 9:30 to 11 AM with the service following.
