Frederick Fremont Dinger, Sr., age 82, currently of Clermont, FL and formerly of Monroeville, NJ, passed away on Wednesday, November 13, 2019. The son of the late Galen Mark Dinger, Sr. and Mary Elizabeth (Karterman) Dinger, Fred was born in Lebanon, PA and grew up in Kleinfeltersville, PA. At the age of 18, he enlisted in the United States Marine Corps where he served his country in their reserve for eight years. In 1956, Fred moved to Barnegat, NJ and, in 1958, was married to Barbara Mae Newman. In 1967, the family moved to Monroeville, NJ.

Fred was a member of Local 825 out of Springfield, NJ for 50 years and worked as an operating engineer until his retirement in 2002.
