Gene L. Rieti, 66, of Elmer passed away on January 13, 2014. Born in Bridgeton, Gene was the son of Geno & Agnes (Bifulco) Rieti. For eighteen years, Gene had worked as a Lab Instructor at Vineland High School. Afterwards, he worked for and was very instrumental in creating the NJ Youth Corp., which was out of the Vineland Adult Education Center. Gene was an avid hunter and fisherman. In fact, he travelled throughout the world hunting and fishing with his friends. He was also a member of the Master Chef Society and had served as its President at both the state and local levels. Gene had also been a member of St. Ann's R.C. Church in Elmer.
