



Harvey Hancock Tice

Harvey Hancock Tice, 91, of Lower Alloways Creek, passed away peacefully at Inspira Hospital in Vineland on June 13, 2025. Harvey was born in Woodbury, NJ., the son of George Y and Beulah (Hancock) Tice. He grew up in Clarksboro, NJ, and graduated from Swedesboro High School class of 1951. He was married to Doris (Ledden) Tice for 65 years.

Harvey was hired by Mobil Oil Corporation (now Exxon-Mobil) at the Paulsboro refinery. He later transferred to the R&D Division, where he worked until retirement. While working in R&D, he earned his Stationary Operating Engineer License. He retired in 1989 as the Supervisor of Labor and Facility Services.

Harvey became a 32nd degree Mason, joining the Paulsboro Masonic Lodge in 1959, followed by membership in the Excelsior Consistory in 1964. Harvey was a former member of the East Greenwich Volunteer Fire Department and Zion Methodist Church.

Harvey loved boating. He was a member of the “Idiots” Boat Club and the Swedesboro Boat Club. He was also a member and later an instructor in the United States Coast Guard Auxiliary.

Following the death of his grandfather and namesake, Harvey and his wife

Doris acquired the family farm in Lower Alloways Creek Township and eventually left Clarksboro to retire to the farm. The farm has been in the family for 202 years. Harvey found joy in maintaining the lawns, lanes and creekbanks and being outside operating and tinkering with his many pieces of farm equipment.

Harvey is survived by his wife, Doris; his daughter, Laura Tice Crane; and his grandson, Daniel Hancock Crane (Jamie Munyon), all residing in Lower Alloways Creek. He is also survived by his sister-in-law, Joan Tice, niece Sharon Tice DelCotto (Anthony), nephew Thomas N. Tice, and great-nephew Marc DelCotto.

Harvey is preceded in death by his parents; brother Norman Tice, brother-in-law David Ledden, and in-laws William A. and Amy (Harvey) Ledden

Services will be held on Tuesday, June 24, 2025, at the Adams Funeral Home, 64 Broad Street, Woodstown, NJ 08098. The viewing will begin at 10 AM, with the service following at 11 AM.
